Lynne had resigned from her role in September 2025, as she and Andy had moved to Gairloch. We will miss Lynne's enthusiasm, warm humour and quiet efficiency in her work for COOL. Our thoughts and prayers are for Andy, who cared for her so selflessly and who will miss her most of all. May the Lord bring the comfort only He can bring to broken, grieving hearts.

2025 has been a **challenging year** for COOL.

Financially we have seen an increase in expenditure and a drop in giving. We have been successful in several grant applications, which has gone some way towards meeting the shortfall.

However, we need to encourage a long term, sustainable income stream if COOL is to continue running. Also, we have struggled to find enough volunteers to help with the activities and clubs we want to run. Turnout at COOL prayer events has been disappointing.

For COOL to continue to function as an outreach and support to local youth we need committed people to pray, volunteer and to contribute financially.
