# YOUTH WORKER REPORT

## *Primary School Assemblies*

This term, our primary school assemblies have been a real highlight. The children have shown **fantastic curiosity**, asking thoughtful questions and engaging in meaningful discussions about the Bible and the nature of God. We've incorporated some of the "decider skills" into our sessions, helping pupils consider the lives that were transformed through **encounters with Jesus**. The Easter assembly was especially impactful, encouraging everyone to explore the facts around Jesus' death and resurrection, rather than simply relying on popular opinion. This term, as well as the usual assemblies, we will be meeting with the **P7 pupils** as they prepare to make **the move to High School**.

## *High School Bible Study Club*

Our Bible study club in the high school continues to **flourish**, with a committed core group of **five or six young people** attending regularly. Together, we've been journeying through the gospel of Luke, delving into what Jesus said and did, and reflecting on how his words are still relevant to our lives today. Some passages have challenged us, but each session has brought **fresh insights** and **genuine growth** for all involved.

## **Friday Youth**

Friday afternoons remain a **cornerstone** of our weekly programme, thanks in large part to our dedicated volunteers. We regularly welcome between **20 and 30 young people** who come for the games, competitions, hot food, and the sense of community. It's wonderful to see **friendships deepen** and new faces feel at home in a **safe, welcoming environment**. This term, our discussions have centred on the theme **'One Life'**, prompting everyone to think about the importance of making good choices in all areas of life.

## **Friday Night Youth**

We have been taking a small group of young people up to **Portree** once a month to join with the **Skye Bible Church** youth which has been a huge blessing. In the remote parts of the Scottish Highlands, as it maybe the case in other remote parts, there are not many young people in our school who have **followed Jesus**. For those that have, or are interested in finding out more, it is so important for them to meet with other young people who have a similar desire, which this partnership gives beautifully.
